November 13-19, 2017



Monday: Philippians 2:1-11 The word **humble** in our society can come across as weak or low self-esteem. As a matter of fact, the dictionary puts it as synonymous with insignificant. I don't know about you, but I don't see Jesus as insignificant. Jesus turns everything upside down. For a Christian, **humble** elevates people to new heights. Today, go counter to the worldly culture and find a way to empty yourself of pride, and **humble** yourself before others. In prayer, reflect how that went, asking God to guide you in your effort to be more like Jesus.

Tuesday: Psalm 63 Wow! Have you ever been so thirsty for God like David? Pray through this psalm today, thirsting for God presence and protection.

Wednesday: 1 Corinthians 12:4-11 What a creative God we have! Do you ever think about how we are all the same, yet different? We sort of look the same, yet different. We walk, yet differently. We speak, yet differently. We all have gifts, yet different ones. I guess you can say God created diversity. Pray in thanksgiving for your different-ness and the different-ness of others, and how they all work toward the common good.

Thursday: Psalm 90 Reflect on the frailty of our human lives, and pray in verse 16-17 so that God's work may be manifested through our lives.

Friday: Romans 6:1-4 Does that first verse kind of make you chuckle? We have been justified through our faith in the resurrection of Christ, so shouldn't we keep sinning just to prove to the world that we are justified by faith not by works? I guess that may be the way someone who has not been transformed by Christ might see it, but Paul is very clear that, no, you have been transformed through the death and resurrection of Christ. Pray in the transformed new life that you have been given through your faith in the death and resurrection of Christ.

Saturday: Psalm 10 Since the Fall with Adam and Eve, the wicked have been attacking the meek and humble. I wonder if, sometimes, we think this is a new thing; people being mean to each other? How often do you hear, 'In my day, we had more respect for _____'? Fill in the blank with just about anything. The good news is that God is always inclining His ear to us. I don't get why the world has to be so evil, but I am thankful that our faithful God is always willing to listen to my gripes, concerns, and worries. Pray to our Faithful God who is bending down to hear you cries.

Sunday: Mark 10:13-16 We have come full circle this week. We started with **humble** and end the week with **meekness**. Children come to life with very little clout/power and a whole lot of wonder and awe. Worship God today as a child with awe and wonder.
