Monday: Galatians 4:4-7 To us a child was born to take away the burden of the law and bring us to salvation through Him. Pray in thanksgiving for the gift of Jesus, and thus the gift of salvation.

Tuesday: Isaiah 9:1-7 We hear the prophecy of the coming Savior! Again, we hear how the burden has been broken by the birth of the Messiah. Pray in joy for the lifting of burdens, and in thanksgiving for God's kingdom breaking forth.

Wednesday: John 1:14-18 The law always convicts us, but now that the Word has been made flesh, we have grace and truth through faith in Christ. Does that unburden you to the law and bring you joy to follow the Word made flesh? In prayer, unburden yourself at the feet of Christ, accepting his grace and truth.

Thursday: Psalm 2 Is this another prophecy of the coming Son? I don't know about you, but I would rather take refuge at God's feet than have Him laughing at my plans. Pray with joy that you can take refuge at God's feet through faith in the Son.

Friday: James 1:17-18 Have you ever thought of yourself as God's first fruit offering to the world? Do you live a generous life as God's first fruit to your community? Pray that your life will be seen as God's offering to your community.

Saturday: Psalm 22 Just as David cried these words, just as Jesus cried out these words, we, too, can take that same position of complete submission to God and cry out these words, trusting that they will be heard. Pray in submission and obedience so that you can be unburdened by this world and have joy in God's kingdom.

Sunday: 2 Corinthians 9:15 Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift! Pray in thanksgiving for the birth of Jesus, the ministry of Jesus, the sacrifice of Jesus, and the redemption that Jesus brings through His resurrection.
