## January 29-February 4, 2018

**Monday: Psalm 107:4-9** Probably many of us see the homeless as wanderers, but don't you feel like a wanderer sometimes? We feel a little lost in this world. We feel untethered and unsure how our needs are going to be met. We have our homeless moments, too. Pray in your wandering, trusting God to provide what you need, and then in turn, help provide for someone else's need.

**Tuesday: Romans 12:19-20** If you only read verse 20, you might think God wants you to have a vengeful heart. I don't think that is what God wants us to get out of these verses. I think he is telling us to be kind and love others...leave the vengeance to me. I guess for me it goes back to how highly do you think of yourself. We are just lowly, loved servants of God. Pray that you will love all people, even your enemies, and leave the wrath and vengeance to God.

**Wednesday: John 6:26-35** I guess it's human nature, '*God, what are you doing for us today?*' Do you find yourself falling into that same trap? Pray to receive the Bread of Life so that you will no longer hunger.

**Thursday: Exodus 16:4** Bread from Heaven! Reflect on the character of God who provided manna and quail in the wilderness, praying to God how you can be His hands and feet in this world.

**Friday: Matthew 14:20-21** Reflect on the compassion of Jesus, praying that God fill you with that same compassion.

**Saturday: John 21:15-18** Is the depth of your love for God reflected in your care of His sheep? Praise God for His love and strength to live out His love.
