Monday: Psalm 102:12-28 When life gets hard, we all tend to become a bit inward-focused. We put blinders on about

the life around us and focus on what we have going on. David recognized that in himself and turned it around. He stopped and took stock in who God is and the faithfulness of God. Today as you pray, look up, not in, recognizing God's power and faithfulness in your life and praise Him.

Tuesday: 2 Kings 8:1-6 God's timing and restoration. Oh, how hard it is to understand God's timing and wait for His restoration. Pray for the faith and strength to wait for the restoration God has promised you.

Wednesday: Mark 3:7-12 Why do you think Mark points out that the unclean spirits recognized Jesus as the Son of God and fell down before Him? Do you think that the unclean spirits see Jesus more clearly than His disciples and followers? Reflect on this and pray about your ability to clearly see Jesus.

Thursday: Psalm 50:1-7 Do you hear the call of God? Pray, asking God to speak to your heart, and then just sit quietly and listen.

Friday: 1 **Timothy** 1:12-20 Did this reading make you think of *'there but for the grace of God I go'*? We sin, we try, but we continue to sin; yet, God redeems us with His grace and mercy. May that strengthen you to... *'fight the good fight, having faith and a good conscience.'* Pray on God's mercy and grace in your life.

Saturday: Luke 19:41-44 This reading kind of makes me weep. I wonder if God looks at my life and weeps for my lack of sight. It is a sad thought, indeed. My prayer for me is that I do not make Jesus weep today. What about you?

Sunday: *Transfiguration of our Lord* **Mark 9:2-9** Do you ever wonder what Jesus, Elisha, and Moses were talking about? I know, I have digressed and they were sworn to secrecy, but I have to wonder if they heard any of it and what they thought. I think for Peter, James, and John, this was like a mini heaven of their heroes. To be there with them, soaking up whatever they offered. Do you have times like that in your life, where you just want to stay in a place and soak up the light, instead of getting back into the trenches and dealing with the hard stuff? Pray where God wants you to be right now.
