Monday: Romans 13:7-9 Owe nothing to anybody...except love.

First we must love, then maybe the rest will fall into place. What does the love that God is asking us to have for our neighbor look like? Pray for God to show you how to truly love others.

Tuesday: Psalm 51:1-3 Pray through this Psalm today seeking mercy.

Wednesday: John 21:15-19 How frustrating it can be to have to repeat the answer to the same question over and over. Even here, we hear that Peter was hurt by Jesus repeating the same question over and over; yet you have to wonder. Was Jesus really getting asking the question, or was he more interested in what He says should be our response to our love of Him? Pray, seeking God's answer to how He wants you to respond to your love of Him.

Thursday: Psalm 51:4-12 Pray through this Psalm today seeking restoration.

Friday: Luke 7:44-50 How do you respond to God's mercy and steadfast love? Have you gotten to a place of complacency; maybe taken it for granted? Or you do respond with extravagant thankfulness? Do you see God's love and mercy as the extravagant gift we each receive? Pray with exuberance, thanking God for the gift of His love and mercy.

Saturday: Psalm 51:13-19 Pray through this Psalm today seeking a willing heart.

Sunday: Matthew 22:37-40 First things first. It is so easy to get priorities confused. We think the squeaky wheel, in the moment of annoyance, the loudest voice of dissent, is where our first priority lies. Go back to Monday; first things first and then just maybe the rest will fall into place. Pray for strength to quiet the noise of this world so that you can love God with your whole being, and then respond to that love by letting it flow from you to others.

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
