Monday: Genesis 1 The big bang! I know there is controversy whether it was a big bang or God creating the world. But really, isn't the story of God creating the world a big bang of **wow**? Am I the only one who thinks God was being a little too humble in saying it was 'good'? I wish we could hear God exclaim amazing, beautiful, perfect, etc. Today, look at all of God's creations and praise Him for his incredible work. Look at how your body knows to breathe, how the plants know how to grow, and the sun knows to rise and set. Pray to our creative creator for the possibilities He has laid before us.

Tuesday: John 11:1-44 Lazarus was dead and buried, yet because of Him (Jesus), he walks out of the tomb! Do you see the miracles in your life because of Him who cares for all? Pray for God to bring you out of whatever tomb you are in, recognizing that you have eternal life through Jesus Christ.

Wednesday: Ezekiel 3:1-14 At times, do you feel like you are in the valley of dry bones? Allow God's Word to breathe life back into your life. Maybe you know someone who is laying in the valley of dry bones; then share God's Word with them so that God may breathe life back into them. Pray for God's Spirit to revive His people and fill them with the hope that can only come from Him.

Thursday: Ephesians 2:1-10 We are alive only through God's mercy through the sacrifice of Christ. Reread verses 4-6, and pray in thanksgiving that God has saved us through His work...not ours.

Friday: Luke 12:22-34 Worry is such a human endeavor! Oh, how highly we think of ourselves and how little we realize that it is only through God's immense mercy and faithfulness that we are even on this earth! Pray in thanksgiving for all that God has given you, and pray for God to increase your faith in Him.

Saturday: Isaiah 26 Reread verse 2, and pray on the truth in that passage.

Sunday: John 3:14-21 Time and time again God comes to the rescue of His children, to the point of sacrificing His Son. How do we still miss that 'without Him there is no me?' I don't know. I do know that I have to remind myself daily that I am here because God wants me here.
