**Monday: Matthew 12:33-37** Ouch! How life giving are the words you speak? Pray in **Psalm 19:14**, Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable to you, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer.

**Tuesday: James 1:12-16** I am deceived daily. My own wants and desires get in the way of my relationship with God. Thank goodness I/we have a God that knows this and daily helps me/you/us to renew a right relationship with Him.

**Wednesday: 1 Corinthians 10:14-22** Pray in verse 17, thanking God for the many brothers and sisters we share not only communion in the Body and Blood of Christ with, but also in communion through our community; that they receive all the good blessings that come from God.

**Thursday: Galatians 6:6-10** I can get caught up with the end of the 10<sup>th</sup> verse that says '...and especially for those of the family of faith.' My righteous indignation gets in the way for me to see the whole picture. It is very clear that we are to work for the good of EVERYONE. Maybe the additional especially is to remind us to be kind to our 'family in faith' since God knows that we tend to be harder on those we love than on others. Pray that you are uplifting all people, including those closest to you.

**Friday: Philippians 3:7-11** This world tells us it is all about us and how successful we are is about us....us, us, us. God has a way of flipping that upside down. It is not about us; it is about what God is doing through us and for us. Pray that you may be an empty vessel for God to work through.

**Saturday: Titus 2:11-14** The word **zealous** or **having zeal** can have a negative connotation of over the top. Maybe we should look at it about what you are zealous about. Do you have zeal for the next greatest gadget, or do you have zeal to do the good works that God has placed before you? Pray for God's spirit to fill you with zeal for Christ Jesus.

**Sunday: Palm Sunday Mark 15:1-47** Today, as we celebrate the beginning of the end of the beginning, pray at the foot of the cross, thanking God for the sacrifice of Jesus Christ so that we may have eternal life with Him.
