Monday: Colossians 4:1-6 Gracious speech...how do I speak to others? Do I speak with grace and a sprinkle of salt, or is it coarse salt with little grace? Pray for God to help you modulate your speech so that it is gracious to those who hear it.

Tuesday: Genesis 33:4-6 Gracious blessings...even when we are not the best that we can be, can we recognize the blessings that God has given us? Pray: Good and Gracious Father, thank you for the gifts of the life you have blessed me with.

Wednesday: Matthew 11:25-30 Gracious will...faith like a child; an infant even. Do you find that the more you try to make sense of your faith, the less you understand? Lord, let me hand over my doubt, my questions, my quest for more, so that you may carry this burden and I may walk in peace with You.

Thursday: Numbers 6:24-26 Gracious peace...bless those around you today with God's peace.

Friday: Philippians 1:27-30 Gracious suffering...I don't know about you, but I prefer not to suffer; however, if I am living a life worthy of the gospel, I may have to take in some suffering for it. Pray for the strength to endure this world's suffering, knowing in the end God is the victor.

Saturday: Psalm 26:10-12 Gracious redemption...pray for redemption as you walk on God's solid ground with integrity and purpose.

Sunday: Luke 10:20-22 Gracious will...does this sound familiar? Look at Wednesday's reading from Matthew. They are almost the same, so I guess it may be worth repeating. Surrender to God's will, not this world's demands, so that you may know the Father through faith in the Son.
