

# Personal DailyWalk

May 14-20, 2018



**Monday: Isaiah 55:10-11** What's your confidence level today? Do you believe God has this world in his hands? Can you trust that God has a plan, even if you don't know what it is? Can you have faith that God's plan is ultimately good for all? Today, pray that God gives you the confidence these verses promise.

**Tuesday: Matthew 23:25-26** Yikes, we may need to take this chapter one woe at a time, but for today, let's just look at woe #7. Pray in this woe, asking for assurance where you are clean and help for guidance where you need some cleaning.

**Wednesday: 1 John 1:8-10** Confession is good for the soul. Today, reflect on this confession and spend time with God in prayer over whatever you are struggling with. God knows it; He wants to be with you and help you through the struggle.

**Thursday: Revelation 3:15-22** These verses make me think of that scene in 'War Room.' What's your temperature? Is it time to engage earnestly with God's Spirit? Pray that His Spirit refines you in His fire.

**Friday: James 2:8-13** I love the end of these verses; mercy triumphs over judgment. Can we leave the judging to God and focus our energy on loving our neighbor? Verse 13 really gets to the heart of how God feels about anyone who does not show mercy to others. Pray for God to show you where you need to soften your heart and show mercy.

**Saturday: Philippians 3:12-16** Do you beat yourself up for what you have done in the past; the wrongs you have committed; the un-Christ-like behaviors of your past? Can we emulate Paul and leave our past with God and strain forward to the future that God is presenting to us, trusting God to teach and model us into that future? Pray, giving your past to God and asking for His hand to lead you forward into His future.

**Sunday: John 15: 1-17** Reflect on these verses and on the word 'abide.' Synonyms: comply with, obey, observe, follow, keep to, hold to, conform to, adhere to, stick to, stand by, act in accordance with, uphold, heed, accept, go along with, acknowledge, respect. In your life, what would be different if you truly abided in God? Are there days that you abide better than others? What is different on those days? Pray, asking God to help you abide in Him more, and for you to feel Him abiding in you.

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
