June 25 – July 1, 2018



Monday: Genesis 5:28-32 Noah's birth. Pray in thanksgiving for the foresight of Noah's father, Lamech, and for courage and strength that you, too, may bring relief to others.

Tuesday: Genesis 6 Sometimes this is hard to read when I think of how merciful God is. It brought a question to my mind. Noah was faithful to God when he did what God asked in building the Ark. I wonder if God asked more men to build an Ark and Noah was the only faithful listener? How many hear the Word of God, yet don't respond? Pray, asking God to show you what He desires for your life, and then do it.

Wednesday: Genesis 7:1-24 Has God asked you to build an Ark that he can shut you in and keep you safe from the disaster of this fallen world? Could God's Word, faithful community, and prayer be the Ark of this time for us? Pray that God shows you the shelter that He has provided for you as you navigate the troubled waters of this fallen world.

Thursday: Genesis 8 Patience. Imagine, the rain has finally stopped. How hard it must have been to wait before opening up the Ark. I get a little cabin fever with two days of rain; imagine 40 days/nights of rain and an additional 110 days for the earth to dry out enough to survive! Noah remained faithful to God's instructions. Pray that even when you think you can't be patient any longer, you are able to remain faithful to God, trusting He has it worked out so that you may have abundant life.

Friday: Genesis 9:1-17 We can't walk with Noah without reading about God's covenant and sign from God. Look for the rainbows – be on the lookout for God's grace and mercy, whether it is an actual rainbow, or maybe it is a rainbow of joy from a person. Pray for God's rainbows to shine bright in your life.

Saturday: Psalm 1 Are you the tree in verse 3? Your roots drinking up the Living Water of God, bearing good fruit in your season, and remaining alive and vibrant? If so, pray in thanksgiving to the God of the Living Water. If not, pray for God to plant your roots in His Living Water so that you may be truly alive in Christ.

Sunday: Hebrews 11:4-7 May you become an unforgettable character in God's story through your faith. We may not be perfect, we may have moments of weakness or stubbornness, but in the end, God provides for those who have faith in Him. Pray for God to enter your life daily.
