Monday: Proverbs 16:1-9 As we learn about Esther this week, we probably should ponder God's placement of us in His greater plan. Verse 9 makes me think of the adage, 'when man plans, God laughs.' I wonder if that is only true when man plans without consulting God, and then does God laugh or cry at the plans we make without Him? Pray for God to give you a sense of what His purpose is for you in this place at this time.

Tuesday: Esther 4 Has God placed you in a place where you can speak for those who can't speak for themselves? Do you have the courage of Esther to do what God's purpose for you is, no matter how difficult it may seem? Pray for God's strength and protection as you fulfill God's purpose in your life.

Wednesday: Psalm 3 Listen carefully to what this Psalm is saying. The world may tell us that God can't save or sustain us. Should we listen to the world and try to save ourselves? Or, should we rely on God's promises of protection, shelter, and provisions so that He may save us? Pray, carefully listening for God's whisper of love.

Thursday: 2 Corinthians 1:3-7 Just as God comforts us in our time of suffering, we should comfort others in their time of suffering. Who needs to be comforted today? Pray for God to show you who needs your comforting arms around them so that they, too, may feel the comfort that comes from God.

Friday: Micah 6:6-8 Read, reflect, and pray in these verses, asking God to show you how to do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with God.

Saturday: Romans 8:18-30 Are you groaning? I know I'm groaning. I try to set my sights on the hope that comes from God's promise of good, but there are things in this world that just make my heart ache. Pray for God's Spirit to build up your hope and set your feet on God's purpose for you in the here and now.

Sunday: John 14:15-31 The Holy Trinity! Pray for the Holy Spirit to open you mind, heart, and soul to all that God needs you to learn, so that you may live in harmony with Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
